The **IHF Awards** are presented in recognition of excellence that has been demonstrated in seven categories, with performance judged against specific criteria.

If you do choose to submit the same solution to both the Innovation Hub and IHF Awards, you must note this in your entry to both programmes and provide the same contact information for both submissions.
