

AHRA 2014: Carestream Presents Imaging Processes From Around the World

Innovative approaches are being deployed around the globe that we can use to establish best practices at U.S. facilities," said Todd Minnigh. "One example is how a closely timed, synchronized patient flow at an imaging centre in São Paulo allowed a small facility to meet a growing demand for imaging studies."
