

Ardent Announces Senior Leadership Appointments and Promotions



Ardent Health Services announced the appointment of two new senior operations leaders and the promotion of three executives to expanded roles.

Mike Matthews has been appointed president of Ardent Physician Services. Dolan, who joined Ardent in 2020, has more than three decades of nursing leadership experience.

Smith, who previously served as vice president of digital and innovation, will assume responsibility for all digital, marketing and branding across Ardent. He joined Ardent in 2021, bringing nearly two decades of experience in healthcare marketing and digital strategy.

Rebecca Kirkham has been promoted to serve as chief communications officer. Kirkham joined Ardent in 2021 as vice president of communications, bringing more than 25 years of experience in strategic healthcare communications. She will continue to lead Ardent's overall communications strategy with oversight of all internal and external communications as well as brand and reputation management efforts.
