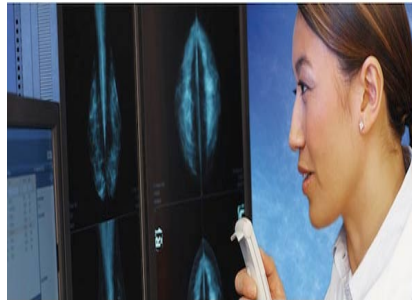

Belgian University Hospital Improves Mammography Services With Sectra's PACS



The Vrije Universiteit Brussels has awarded a five-year contract to the IT and medical technology company Sectra for the supply of a breast imaging PACS (system for handling diagnostic images for mammography).

By providing instant access to images including relevant patient history, Sectra's solution will allow the hospital to improve the quality of its services to women participating in the Belgian breast screening program.

All digital breast images, regardless of modality vendor, are automatically displayed in the same size with correct orientation and alignment, facilitating comparison of current and prior images.
