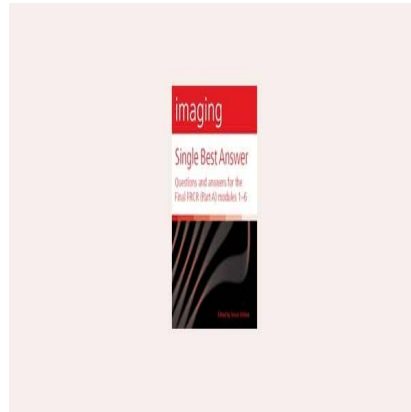




British Institute of Radiology Publishes New Book, App
