

European eHealth Week 2011 Confirms Participation of Prominent Organisations, Partners, Exhibitors and Country Pavilions



EU-wide networking and information platform unites fragmented industry behind a common goal: Advancing the application of eHealth in Europe.

eHealth Week 2011 has announced which eHealth organisations and industry partners will participate in this year's event to exchange views with EU governments representatives (Budapest, Hungary, 10-12 May, 2011). Among them, the Innovative Medicines Initiative (IMI), Germany's Federal Association for Information Technology (BITKOM), the European MHealth Alliance, the Continua Health Alliance, Netc@rds and ASIP Sante. Sweden, Turkey, Denmark and other major countries will showcase their projects on the exhibition floor in a country pavilion, alongside some of the largest industry partners such as HP, AGFA, Magyar Telekom / Deutsche Telekom and INTEL.
