



ICU Management 1-1-1 Interviews

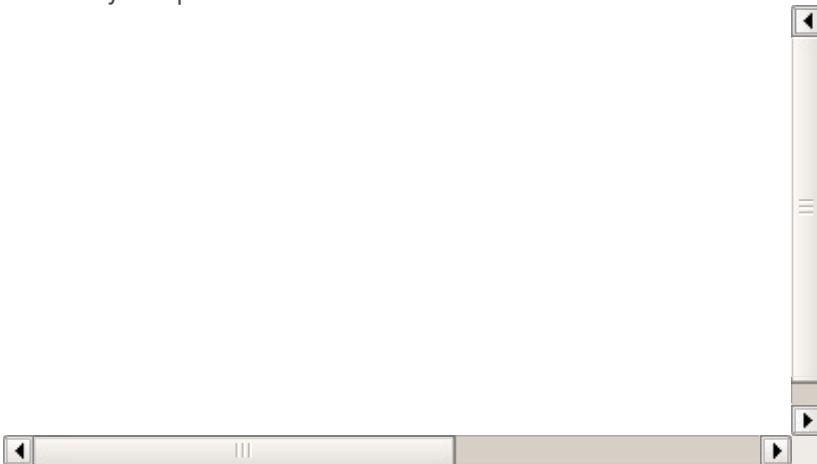
