With the mission of ZERO preventable deaths by 2020 (0X2020), PSMF is committed to unifying the healthcare ecosystem and further implementing evidence-based best practices to save thousands of lives and reduce healthcare costs.

"We can no longer hope for ZERO preventable patient deaths; we must plan for ZERO," explains Joe Kiani, Founder, and Chairman of the Patient Safety Movement Foundation (pictured). "We are thrilled to partner with HealthManagement.org to publish the latest information on news, technology and evidence-based best practices surrounding the leading causes of preventable patient harm. Medical errors are preventable. By learning about best practices and leadership implemented by hospitals, we can enable healthcare personnel to improve patient safety around the world. Together we can make a difference."
